Meet the Lees



Je Hoon Lee, a social worker and active duty service member in the U.S. Army, and his wife, June Choi, wanted to send their children, Elliot and Ashlyn, to Catholic school.

The Fulcrum Foundation's Tuition Assistance Grant Program helped make it happen. Both Elliot and Ashlyn received Fulcrum aid in the 2019-2020 school year to attend Bellarmine Preparatory School in Tacoma.

"We can't always go through life as we've planned," Je Hoon said. "But the existence of God has always helped me through. I'm from South Korea and my entire family is strong in Buddhism. I didn't always have a chance to practice my faith. When we had kids, I looked for the opportunity to implement the blessing of faith in our children."

Je Hoon felt drawn to Bellarmine because of the school's strong Catholic identity. "They have all-school Mass, religion classes, and requirements for community service hours, which I never expected in the public schools. My children learned what the love of God is through all-school Mass and religion classes, and how to serve the community and our neighbors through their community service. These are things I couldn't teach to my children."

Ashlyn is now a junior at Bellarmine, while Elliot has enrolled in the United States Military Academy at West Point, serving his community and country, which he learned from Bellarmine.

"Catholic education is the way to go," Je Hoon said. "I'm really thankful to Fulcrum for the initial momentum so that we could send our kids to Bellarmine."

New Technology at Holy Family School



Holy Family School in Auburn needed new desktop computers and laptops for their teachers and students, because their current equipment was failing and out of date.

Fulcrum's School Partnership Grant Program provided enough funding for Holy Family to purchase 27 new desktop computers and 26 new laptops. Many of these new computers helped outfit the library, where Holy Family teaches lessons in technology to all grade levels to prepare them for high school.

"We really needed our students to have access to technology," explained Michele Corey, principal of Holy Family. "And the timing couldn't have been better."

When the COVID-19 pandemic sent schools to remote learning in the spring of 2020, Holy Family was able to use some of their new devices to reach students at home.

"The Fulcrum grant really gave a calmness to the staff. There was a feeling of 'we got this," Michele said of the transition to remote learning. "Holy Family is a special place. It's a school where faith goes together with education."

"We're so grateful to Fulcrum, both now and through the years," Michele added. "I don't know how schools would do it without them."

Kathy Cox, a veteran Catholic school teacher, participated in Fulcrum's Leadership Academy in 2018. The following school year, she was appointed vice principal of academics and student support at St. Catherine of Siena School in Seattle.

"While in the program, I learned a great deal about building school culture and identifying the mission of a school," Kathy said. These skills allowed Kathy to create a culture of inclusion at St. Catherine in her new role.

"At St. Catherine, we strive to not only be an inclusive community, but to embrace diverse learners. I've worked closely with teachers in helping them to feel supported, prepared, knowledgeable, and comfortable in this culture."

And when the COVID-19 pandemic hit, Kathy used Fulcrum's training to handle the unexpected challenges facing her school by employing clear and compassionate communication with teachers, families, and students.

"Overall, Fulcrum provided an invaluable learning experience," Kathy said. "If I could look into the future, I'd say it's very likely that I will continue to take the next steps in leadership as a direct result of the opportunity Fulcrum provided through my participation in the Leadership Academy. I have been so impressed with how Fulcrum has celebrated leadership successes with other aspiring teachers. This is certainly a key component in continuing to create the next leaders in Catholic schools."

Our COVID-19 Response

In the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic, Fulcrum's donors have made all the difference in Catholic schools across the Archdiocese of Seattle.

Fulcrum's work over the last couple of years prepared schools for their transition from the classroom to remote learning when school buildings closed in March. The Fulcrum IT Network Modernization Fund updated internal internet access across archdiocesan schools, while the School Partnership Grant Program provided funds for new laptops and tablets for students and teachers alike.

These critical grants and programs allowed the Archdiocese of Seattle to reach a 99% remote learning attendance rate among students, helped teachers continue instruction, and kept students connected with their Catholic communities.

But Fulcrum didn't stop there. Soon after schools went remote, Fulcrum's Board of Trustees took action, approving a COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund for immediate financial relief. The board seeded the COVID-19 Fund with a \$1 million infusion from Fulcrum's own reserves.

| In the first few months following the creation of the COVID-19 Fund, the foundation raised \$3.5 million for the 2020-2021 school year, while Fulcrum's Distribution Committee created an entirely new, easy-to-use application process accessible to all schools in the archdiocese.

Through this new process, every school may apply for a \$60,000 grant to cover tuition assistance, purchasing new equipment and technology, and creating safe classroom spaces. Fulcrum will allow additional funding requests as the COVID-19 Fund grows.

Thank you, Fulcrum donors, for answering the call and helping archdiocesan schools thrive even in these challenging times!

Led by co-chairs Shawn and Kathie Hoban and Tom and Margaret Hoban, Uplift is a comprehensive, five-year campaign that builds upon Fulcrum's past successes, meets the present needs of our schools, and strives to build a future where Fulcrum can help all families who seek a Catholic education for their children in the Archdiocese of Seattle.



"The Fulcrum Foundation uplifts schools and families through increased access to life-changing education. The goal of Uplift is to create and maintain a sustainable platform for Fulcrum's efforts in the archdiocese well into the future," said Shawn Hoban. "This work and Fulcrum's mission of leveraging support for Catholic schools are certainly worth supporting!"

Fulcrum has raised \$54 million toward the campaign's \$66 million goal!

Uplift will help support Fulcrum's three main pillars—access to opportunity, revitalizing schools, and transformational leadership-opening new and creative avenues of aid in areas such as diversity and inclusion, early childhood education, tuition assistance, and building leadership capacity.

IT Network **Modernization Fund JULY 2019**

The IT Network Modernization Fund, under the leadership of Jan and Tom O'Callahan, continued its five-year mission to supply critical internet access and technology upgrades to schools across the archdiocese, bringing all schools up to the industry minimum standard for internet connection speed.

Diversity Training AUGUST 2019

The Fulcrum Foundation's **Diversity Committee** offered a workshop to train staff, teachers, and administrators of the 72 schools in the archdiocese, featuring keynote speaker Alison Park, founder of Blink Consulting. The workshop focused on understanding school culture and reframing multiculturalism as an inclusive process for the benefit of all students.

Archbishop Etienne SEPTEMBER 2019

The Archdiocese of Seattle welcomed the new Archbishop Paul D. Etienne, following the retirement of Archbishop Emeritus J. Peter Sartain. Archbishop Etienne said he looked forward to "a collaborative process of developing a clear mission and vision for the archdiocese."

New Fulcrum Executive Director OCTOBER 2019

Fulcrum welcomed new Executive Director Vivian Shannon to the team, who brought a track record of inclusive leadership and team building. Before Fulcrum, Vivian served as the senior vice president and chief advancement officer for the YMCA of Greater Seattle.

Celebration of Light JANUARY 2020

The 2020 Celebration of Light was the most successful in history, raising almost \$2.2 million with over 1,100 donors, corporate leaders, and educators in attendance. The event honored Mike and Mary Lee with the Archbishop's Award and built on the success of the previous year which ranked 10th among an elite group of top-grossing charitable events in the Seattle region.

COVID-19 Response APRIL 2020

Through Fulcrum aid and technology grants, the 72 schools of the Archdiocese of Seattle were able to report a 99% remote learning attendance rate for the end of the 2019-2020 school year. Fulcrum responded to the crisis by creating the COVID-19 Emergency Relief Fund, which raised \$3.5 million for schools in the months following the transition to remote learning.

Academic Year

In Review*

Partnership with Office for Catholic **Schools**

Fulcrum's partnership with the Office for Catholic Schools has been strengthened through the work of Kristin Moore, the director of marketing and enrollment, and Kelly Surapaneni, the coordinator for leadership development. These Fulcrum-funded positions have fostered leadership growth, created new marketing initiatives, and strengthened admissions and enrollment efforts in archdiocesan schools.

Ambassador Program

In its second year, the Fulcrum Ambassador Program continued to build momentum by adding more ambassadors and furthering outreach. Before COVID-19 closed school buildings, Fulcrum's nine ambassadors completed 25 school site visits, which included community roundtable discussions and additional parish and school engagement.

Transformational Leaders

In the 2019-2020 school year, each of the 72 archdiocesan schools benefitted from at least one teacher with leadership training from Fulcrum and the Office for Catholic schools, with a total of 135 teacherleaders serving in the elementary schools and 89 instructional leaders in the high schools throughout the Archdiocese of Seattle.

Revitalizing **Schools**

Fulcrum supported 48 of the 72 schools in the Archdiocese of Seattle through several partnership grant programs. Funding areas included capital improvement, technology, diversity and inclusion, and more.

Access to Opportunity

Through the generosity of Fulcrum donors, the foundation awarded over 1,900 grants for tuition assistance in the 2019-2020 school year, allowing families across the Archdiocese of Seattle to realize their dreams of Catholic education.

Early Childhood Education

Through the generous donations of Dick and Sharon Abrams, Fulcrum started the Early Childhood **Education Fund** to support the development and growth of pre-K education within archdiocesan schools. The Abrams also helped create a new, Fulcrum-funded director of early childhood education position at the Office for Catholic Schools.



He also understood that Catholic schools needed additional funding if they were going to remain academically excellent. Under his leadership, Fulcrum Foundation was founded in 2002.




