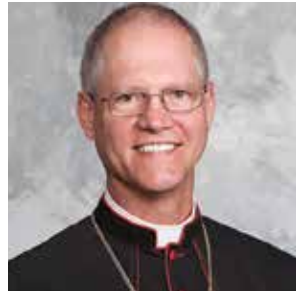

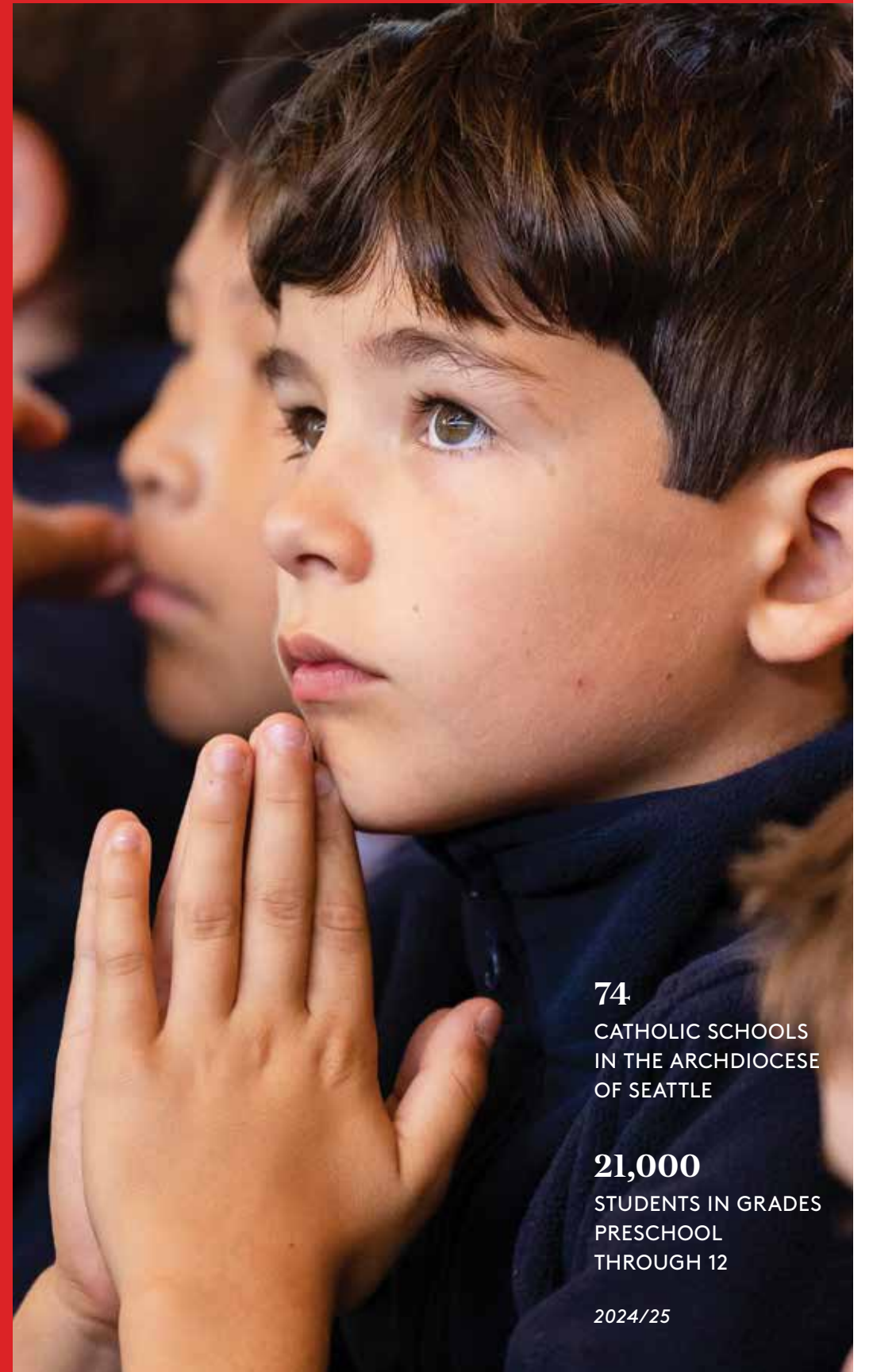

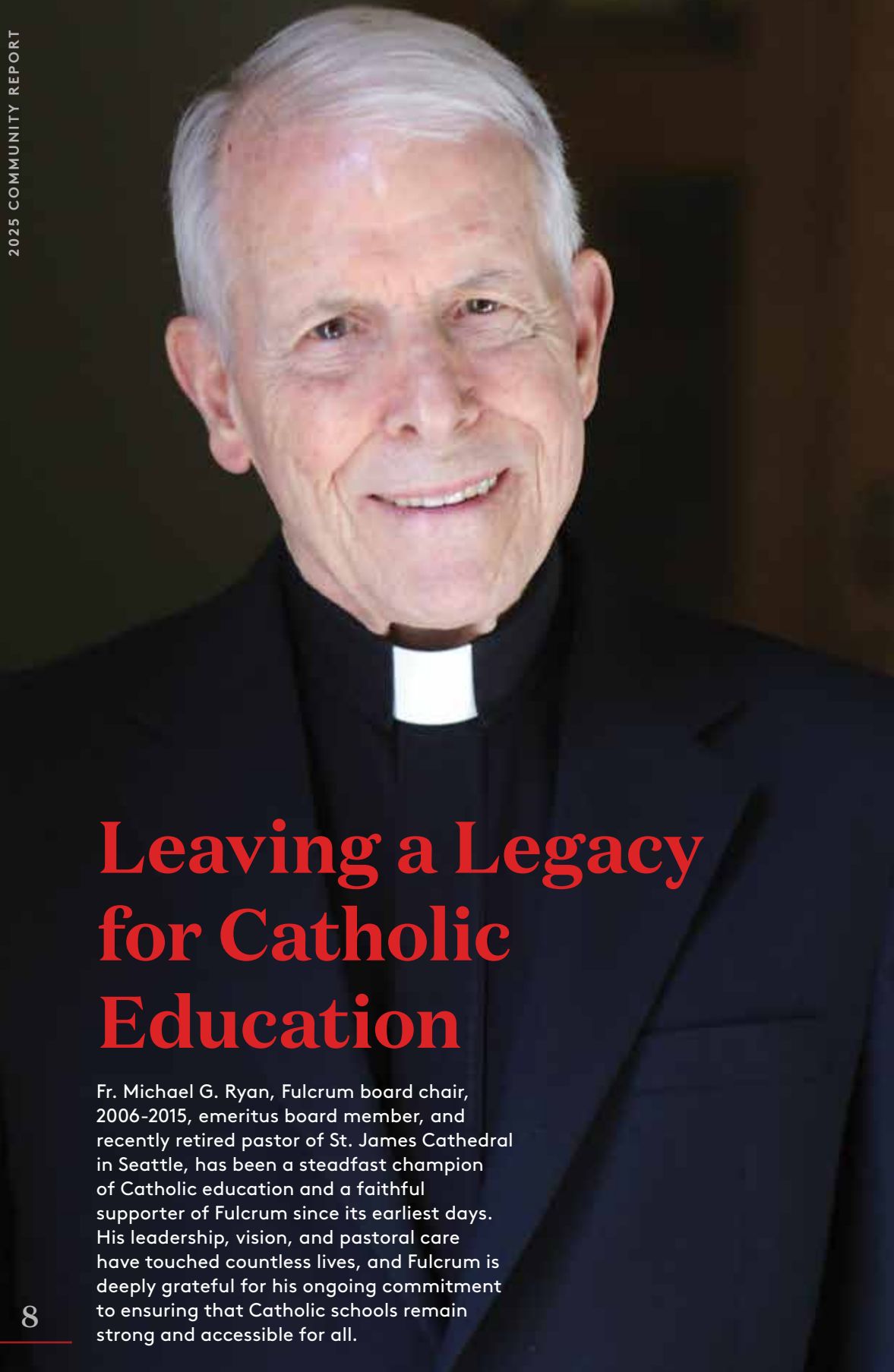

Leaving a Legacy for Catholic Education

Fr. Michael G. Ryan, Fulcrum board chair, 2006-2015, emeritus board member, and recently retired pastor of St. James Cathedral in Seattle, has been a steadfast champion of Catholic education and a faithful supporter of Fulcrum since its earliest days. His leadership, vision, and pastoral care have touched countless lives, and Fulcrum is deeply grateful for his ongoing commitment to ensuring that Catholic schools remain strong and accessible for all.

Under God’s grace, I owe my vocation to the priesthood to my wonderful family, but also to my Catholic education. I very much doubt that I would be a priest today had it not been for Sister Miriam Arlene, my eighth-grade teacher at St. Anne’s School on Queen Anne Hill. I remember a day in 1955 when a priest from St. Edward’s Seminary came to the school to give a pitch about the minor seminary. The priest from St. Edward’s finished his pitch and told us he would be happy to visit afterwards with any of us who might be interested in signing up. Needless to say, none of us lined up. It was hardly a cool thing to do.

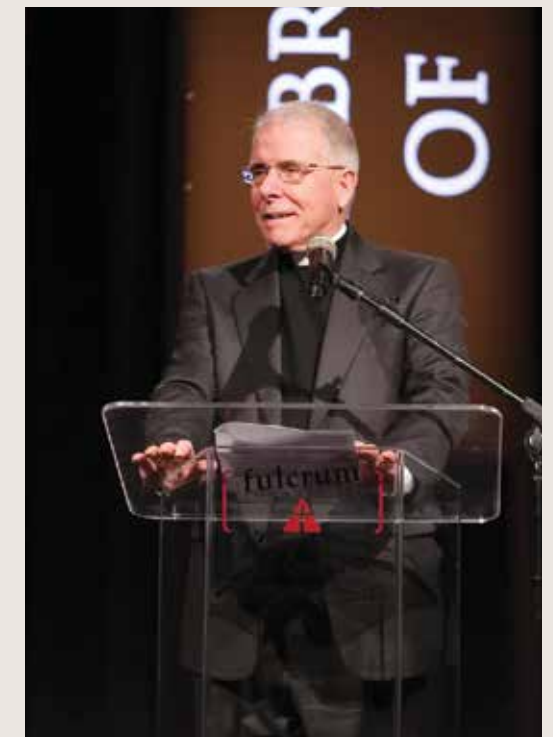
But Sister Miriam Arlene tapped me on the shoulder as I filed out, looked me in the eye, and said, “You’d like to talk with Father, wouldn’t you?” She was right, but how in the world did she know? I’ll tell you why: she was a Catholic school teacher and, like so many of them, she knew her kids! Well, I did talk with the priest that day, and I did sign up, and I did go to St. Edward’s, and twelve years later, in 1966, I was ordained a priest. Almost sixty years ago!

Catholic schools are different today, of course. But our schools are still there, arms wide open, fostering faith, awakening and challenging young minds, fanning the flames of idealism, inspiring young people to service in the name of Christ. What my Catholic education did for me it is still doing for the thousands of young people who fill our classrooms and for the thousands who, with the help of Fulcrum, will fill them in the future.



Over the years, it has been a joy to witness Fulcrum’s incredible growth. Whether through tuition assistance for families, leadership support for principals and teachers, or grants that strengthen schools, Fulcrum truly transforms lives and sustains Catholic education for future generations.

I am privileged to be able to include Fulcrum in my estate plans, and it gives me joy to think that I can help young people in the future receive the immense privilege my parents gave to me: a Catholic education.

Opening Doors Through Tuition Assistance

In classrooms across the archdiocese, students are building brighter futures—and behind many of their stories is an important source of support—Fulcrum’s Tuition Assistance Grant Program, commonly known as TAP.

Designed to reduce financial barriers to Catholic education, TAP is not just helping families afford tuition; it’s strengthening entire school communities and providing students with stability, support, and opportunity.

Since Fulcrum’s inception in 2002, TAP has grown exponentially—both in scope and in the lives it touches.

Catholic education is built on a mission of inclusion, service, and academic excellence. But for many families, cost remains a barrier. That’s where TAP steps in.

In the 2024/25 school year, Fulcrum awarded over \$2.6M in TAP grants reaching more than 1,900 students across Western Washington—the highest in the program’s history. These grants—along with tuition assistance also provided by the local school—help to close the gap for families already making significant financial sacrifices.

The program is financial needs-based, ensuring that assistance goes to the families who need it most. Applications are carefully reviewed, and schools work in tandem with Fulcrum to ensure the program is administered equitably.

But the real story lies not in the numbers, but in the lives changed.

“Without the commitment of the Fulcrum Foundation, my daughter would not have had the opportunity to be the great young woman that she is today. Along a very bumpy road, one thing was always constant: her safety and security inside the walls of her Catholic schools. Her strong faith is a gift that she holds on to tightly. The partnership of the teachers, administrators, coaches and families have all contributed to her success. These great people gave her the strength, opportunities and wisdom to see and understand that she was not a victim of her circumstances but rather could be a champion of her own destiny. As a single mother of two amazing children, I have endless appreciation and am eternally thankful for what the Fulcrum Foundation has done for my family.”

TAP’s growth has mirrored the needs of the communities we serve. As economic challenges have persisted for many families post-pandemic, TAP has adapted to ensure that no family has to choose between faith and finances.

Over the last year, total TAP funding has grown by over 25%.

Fulcrum’s strategic fundraising, generous donor support, and collaboration with the Archdiocese of Seattle have all made this growth possible.

Looking forward, Fulcrum plans to deepen the impact of TAP with continued growth in funding. Every TAP award represents a student, a dream, and a future.

As Fulcrum celebrates another year of record support through TAP, it does so with gratitude for the families, donors, school leaders, and advocates who make this work possible.

Because when one student thrives, a whole community rises.

The Fulcrum Foundation is at the heart of leadership development for Catholic schools across the Archdiocese of Seattle. Thanks to the generosity of Fulcrum donors, the innovative Building Leadership Capacity (BLC) initiative—led by the Office for Catholic Schools (OCS)—are thriving. Together, Fulcrum and the OCS are ensuring that Catholic schools remain a beacon of hope by investing in the people who make them flourish.

Since its launch in 2017, the BLC initiative has been guided by a simple truth: everyone leads all the time. Leadership extends beyond principals to include teachers, admissions and marketing staff, fundraisers, future administrators, and current school leaders. With Fulcrum's support, the OCS has identified, formed, and retained high-quality leaders at every level of the school community. Fulcrum has even funded leadership positions within the OCS, accelerating the development and expansion of BLC programming.

30+ Cohorts, Countless Leaders

Today, more than 30 active BLC cohorts are at work across the Archdiocese of Seattle. These groups, ranging from admissions and fundraising staff to teachers, counselors, and principals, offer professional formation, peer networking, and spiritual growth. By building confidence and capacity, these cohorts make “everyone leads all the time” a lived reality in Catholic schools.

Pathways for Principals

The OCS partners with eight Catholic universities to provide master's degrees in educational leadership and principal certification pathways, with many universities offering a 50% tuition discount for full-time Catholic educators.

This past summer, ten Catholic educators began advanced leadership training at five of the partner universities. Each educator received funding through Fulcrum's Educational Leadership Grant Program, making the opportunity to answer the call

to serve as principals more accessible. Each university program follows a cohort model, building lifelong peer networks of support.

Complementing this, the OCS offers a Leadership Academy where aspiring leaders gain hands-on experience in the four domains of Catholic leadership: mission and Catholic identity, governance and leadership, academic excellence, and operational vitality. Over the last

four years, 23 principals have been hired from within the archdiocese, each formed through BLC programming.

The Fulcrum Impact

Every strong Catholic school is built on strong leadership. By funding Building Leadership Capacity programs, Fulcrum donors are directly shaping the future of Catholic education. Their generosity equips teachers, staff, and principals with the vision, skill, and faith to guide students in learning and service.

Together, Fulcrum and the OCS are cultivating a sustainable culture of leadership—one where every person contributes, and *everyone leads all the time.*


